What is the overall deductible?	<ul> <li>\$7,850 individual / \$15,700 family in-network.</li> <li>\$15,700 individual / \$31,400 family out-of-network.</li> </ul>	Generally, you must pay all of the costs from <u>providers</u> up to the <u>deductible</u> amount before this <u>plan</u> begins to pay. If you have other family members on the <u>plan</u> , each family member must meet their own individual <u>deductible</u> until the total amount of <u>deductible</u> expenses paid by all family members meets the overall family deductible.
Are there services covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> ?	Yes. In-network preventive services, <b>3</b> illness-related office in- network visits, Tier 1 and Tier 2 drugs and some pediatric dental services are covered before you meet your <u>deductible</u> . What is the <u>out-of-pocket</u> limit for this <u>plan</u> ?	For in-network <b>\$7,850</b> individual / <b>\$15,700</b> family.	The <u>out-of-pocket limit</u> is the most you could pay in a year for covered services. What is not included in the <u>out–of–pocket limit</u> ?	All out-of-network cost sharing amounts (deductibles, copays and coinsurance), premiums, balance- billed charges, healthcare this plan doesn't cover, and specialty drug coupon programs payments. Exceptions include out- of-network medical emergency services (including mental health and substance abuse) and out-of- network air ambulance services.
